We will calculate missing angles in polygons, build simple 3D shapes (including making nets), describe positions on the full co-ordinate grid and translate simple shapes on the co-ordinate plane. In preparation for the forthcoming SATS examinations, we will revise the four operations, fractions and negative numbers. The children will have the opportunity to complete practice papers.

Art/DT

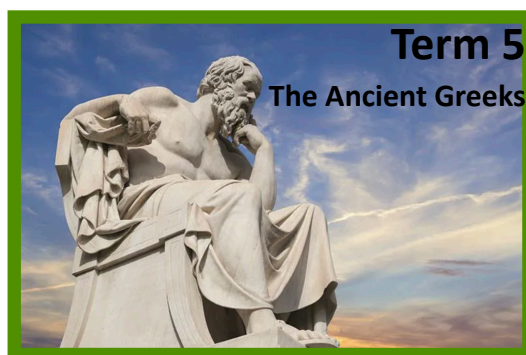
We will be exploring the art of illusion, learning about perspective, foreshortening and trompe l'oeil.

We will also be revising key English skills in preparation for the forthcoming SATS examinations. The children will have an opportunity to practise reading and GPS papers prior to completing the 2025 papers. 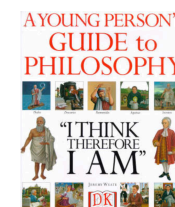
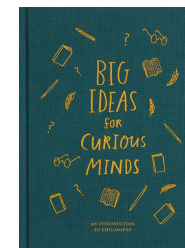
Magic Moments (Enrichment)
