

Maths

During our maths sessions, we will learn about metric and imperial measurements. We will then study algebra. The children will learn how to find a one-step or two-step rule. We will also begin to solve equations and problems with unknown values. By the end of the term, we will start to revisit decimals and learn how to multiply and divide them.

R.E.

Our RE focus this term will be Christianity followed by Islam.

Spanish

We will be exploring some key verbs in the present tense: Vivir, Hablar, Ser.

P.E. (Thursdays)

We will be playing netball and handball outdoors and switching to yoga and pilates indoors.

Art/DT

We will explore Viking patterns and art. We will also use charcoal to create a heath landscape.

PHSE

We will focus on the power of words and discuss the positive and negative aspects of social media.

English

During Term 3, we will continue to read our whole-class text 'Holes' by Louis Sachar. Reading and writing tasks will link with our topics for this term: Macbeth, and later in the term, Scandinavia. We will explore a play script and discuss characters, themes and plot. The children will write an emotive letter, create a poem using rhyming couplets and finally write a discussion text about the downfall of Macbeth. We will revise use of adverbial phrases and consider how we can use conjunctions and adverbials to compare and contrast when writing. We will learn how to create a parenthesis in a sentence.

Geography: biome, climate, culture, polar region, arctic, hemisphere, Nordic, fjord.


Magic Moments (Enrichment)

Topic
