

Ethelbert Road Primary School Junior ICT Rules

Ethelbert Road's ICT Rules will help keep you safe and happy

- I will only use a tablet, iPad or laptop when I am asked to and as part of my learning.
- I will only take a photograph when I have been asked to by a teaching adult. I will not take photographs of others without their permission.
- I will not change the wallpaper or any settings on devices.
- Years 3, 4, 5 - I will not bring personal devices to school. This includes wearable devices, such as, Smart Watches or any device that records sound or pictures. If I need to bring a personal device to school my parent/carer will write to the Headteacher asking permission.
- Year 6 – personal devices brought to school, including wearable devices that record pictures and sound (Smart watches), must be kept in the designated area.
- I ask a teacher about which websites I can use
- I will not assume information online is true
- I know there are laws that stop me copying online content
- I know I must only open online messages that are safe. If I am unsure, I will not open it without speaking to an adult first
- I know that people online are strangers and they may not always be who they say they are
- If someone online suggests meeting up, I will always talk to an adult straight away
- I will not use technology to be unkind to people
- I will keep information about me and my passwords private
- I always talk to an adult if I see something which makes me feel worried

I know that if I do not follow the rules:

I will be supervised 1:1 during lessons

I may miss part of my playtime to discuss why I have broken the rules and how this can be unsafe
