Ethelbert Road's ICT Rules will help keep you safe and happy

- I will only use a tablet, IPad or laptop when I am asked to and as part of my learning.
- I will only take a photograph when I have been asked to by a teaching adult. I will not take photographs of others without their permission.
- I will not change the wallpaper or any settings on devices.
- I am not allowed to bring personal devices to school. This includes wearable devices, such as, Smart Watches or any device that records sound or pictures.

- I only use the internet when an adult is with me.
- I only click on links and buttons online when I know what they do.
- I keep my personal information and passwords safe.
- I only send messages online which are polite and friendly and when it is part of my lesson.
- I know the school can see what I am doing online when I use school computers and tablets, including when I use these at home.
- I always tell an adult/teacher/member of staff if something online makes me feel upset, unhappy, or worried.
