This term, we will finish our unit of work about decimals and percentages. We will be learning how to find equivalents, compare, and order decimals and percentages. We will also revisit rounding and apply this skill to decimals. We will also be learning how to calculate with decimals. After that, we will learn about perimeter and area followed by graphs and tables.

### English

Our English lessons, this term, will link closely with our history topic. We will write a recount of our trip to The Royal Engineers' Museum, and also write our own diary entries inspired by the diary of Anne Frank. During grammar lessons, we will learn to write sentences in the active and passive voice which we will then use in our independent writing.

### PHSE
